**** URGENT MESSAGE FOR ALL EMS PROVIDERS ****

*** NEW *** A minimum of 75% of your required Continuing Education Credits must be in "Medical/Trauma" and 25% may be "Other".

NOTE: Continuing Education may be classroom or <u>online</u> for any amount of CEU's in either category.

Please be reminded it is your responsibility to access the EMS Registry System to verify your status at: www.ems.health.state.pa.us

By viewing your Con Ed Status Report you can see your renewal date, the required amount of Con Ed completed and the amount of Con Ed still required to renew.

EMR – 16 Continuing Education Credits within 3 year renewal period – A minimum of 75% must be in the Medical/Trauma Category

- 12 MEDICAL/TRAUMA May be online or Classroom
- 4 Other May be online or Classroom

EMT-B – 24 Continuing Education Credits within 3 year renewal period – **A minimum of 75%** must be in the Medical/Trauma Category

- 18 MEDICAL/TRAUMA May be online or Classroom
- 6 Other May be online or Classroom

AEMT – 36 Continuing Education Credits within 2 year renewal period – A minimum of 75% must be in the Medical/Trauma Category

27 - MEDICAL/TRAUMA – May be online or Classroom

PARAMEDIC – 36 Continuing Education Credits within 2 year renewal period – A minimum of 75% must be in the Medical/Trauma Category
